This international conference aims at gathering researchers interested in statistical computing in Latin America and from other parts of the world, and will be sponsored by the Brazilian Statistical Association (ABE) and by the International Association for Statistical Computing (IASC). The theme of the 1st LACSC is "Statistical Computing for Data Science".
