The 34th International Workshop on Statistical Modelling (IWSM) will be held in Guimarães (Portugal) 7-12 July 2019. The IWSM2019 aims to involve both academic and professional statisticians and data analysts with a particular focus on real data problems which involve an element of novel statistical modelling, or novel model application. Papers focusing on applications with important substantive implications as well as methodological issues are welcome. Submissions by students and young researchers are particularly encouraged.

The scientific program of the Meeting includes a mini-course taught by Prof. James Carpenter (London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine), renowned specialist in the field of "missing data analysis" and 5 well-known Keynote Speakers experts in several areas of Statistics: Adrian Bowman (University of Glasgow), Julio Singer (University of São Paulo), Maria Antónia Turkman (University of Lisbon), Peter Diggle (Lancaster University) e Philippe Lambert (University of Liege). The scientific program also includes (oral and panel) selected communications.
