V LATIN AMERICAN CONFERENCE ON STATISTICAL COMPUTING Call for Proposals for a Host

The Latin American Regional Section (LARS) of the International Association for Statistical Computing (IASC) invites Universities and Research Centers to participate as Host of the V Latin American Conference on Statistical Computing (LACSC), to be held on the first semester of 2020.

LACSC is the official conference of LARS-IASC, and its main purpose is to foster the progress of the theory, methods and practice of statistical computing in Latin America through international contact among statisticians and computer scientists, as well as external organizations, institutions and government. In 2019, we will have the 4th edition of LACSC in Guayaquil, Ecuador, following its previous yearly editions since 2016 in Gramado (Brazil), Valparaíso (Chile) and San José (Costa Rica).

The selected organization to host the V LACSC will have the opportunity of sharing with students and members of its community the experience of attracting the best researchers as well as to promote new theoretical and practical discoveries in the area of Statistical Computing.

For a proposal to be acceptable, it is required that the proposed host institution be the affiliation of an active member of LARS-IASC at the time of submitting the proposal. The institution will be chosen considering the facilities in logistics, access, lodging and available infrastructure. In addition, other benefits that the institution is able to provide (student aid, internal support, external financing, etc.) will be considered as advantages. The interested LARS-IASC member/organization may submit a self-nomination document addressed to the Chairperson of LARS-IASC describing the main considerations. The proposals that are received before May 20th, will have the opportunity to be considered at the Board of Directors meeting to be held during the IV LACSC in Guayaquil, from May 28 to 30, 2019.
