He was one of the IEEE Geoscience and Remote Sensing Society (GRSS) Distinguished Lecturers from 2015 to 2019. In 2018 he received the IEEE GRSS Regional Leader Award. Since 2019 he serves as AdCom (Advisory Committee) member for this Society, in charge of Future Publications and Plagiarism. His research interests are data visualization, statistical computing, and stochastic modeling, with applications in signal and image processing, and networks.
